Senior Volunteer Services (SVS) is a 501(c)3 volunteer and human services agency whose mission is emphasizing services to mature adults and their communities, offering a rich climate for collaborative and supportive efforts with other nonprofit programs and public agencies. SVS recruits and places senior volunteers in a wide variety of nonprofit and government agencies, throughout San Luis Obispo and Northern Santa Barbara Counties.

Currently, SVS directs and manages the RSVP Retired & Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) for those 55+ and the CCCV Central Coast Community Volunteer Program for those 50+. Both programs focus on utilizing the experience, knowledge and expertise of this valuable human resource to serve local community needs while sustaining the health and vitality of this growing population. During the past year alone, SVS/RSVP volunteers provided over 160,000 hours to the agencies we serve - a \$4.2 million dollar value to the community.

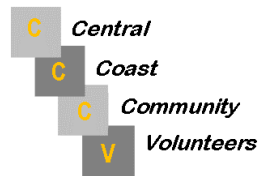

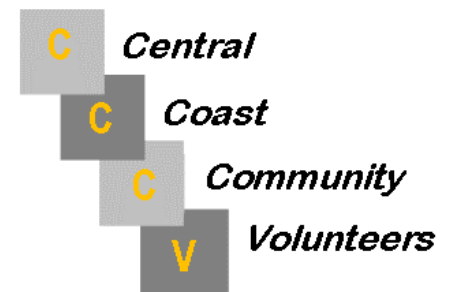

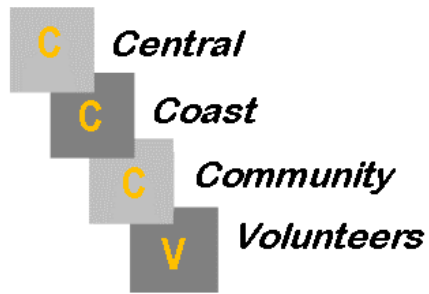

OUR New 50+ Senior Volunteer Program

Our SVS partner agencies often tell us that our volunteers are what make the difference in their ability to deliver much needed services. We want to continue providing skilled, willing, responsible and dedicated senior volunteers to ALL partner agencies who rely on our services. This new CCCV volunteer program will enable us to continue serving ALL the nonprofits and government agencies within our geographic area, regardless of focus. Our goal is to retain agencies and volunteers who no longer qualify under the RSVP revised Federal guidelines, to increase the total pool of senior volunteers in service to our communities and to attract younger seniors, as the semi-retiring or retiring Baby Boomers who are seeking meaningful ways to serve in our communities.

CCCV MISSION

The mission of the CCCV program is the recruitment and placement of 50+ aged seniors in high impact community volunteer opportunities. Engaging seniors in these assignments

- ◆ Offers a wide variety of volunteer opportunities for active mature adults;
- ◆ Fills the ever increasing need to recruit volunteers to meet partner agencies' demands;
- ◆ Has documented health benefits for the senior volunteers as they contribute their skills and talents for the benefit of those agencies whose clients are being served.

CCCV provides opportunities for younger seniors to give back to their community in meaningful ways, while enhancing their own health, vigor and longevity, making new friends, learning new skills, and leading happier and more fulfilling lives. Our ability to attract younger seniors through our new CCCVP (which we cannot do now under RSVP guidelines) will increase opportunities for those individuals to remain healthy longer as they advance in age. This is particularly important in San Luis Obispo, with such a significant number of our population in the "senior" age group. Over the next 15 years, the over 60 population of our area is expected to increase by about double the rate of overall growth for the area.

- ◆ CCCV volunteers receive (at no cost to the agencies or volunteers) a \$1Million supplemental accident/liability/auto policy when they regularly submit their monthly volunteer hours.
