FREE BENEFITS for CCCV 50+ Volunteers

All enrolled RSVP 55+ & CCCV 50+ senior volunteers are eligible to receive our

- **FREE \$1M Accident/Liability Supplemental Insurance** benefit as long as you have an Enrollment Form on file and turn in your volunteer hours each month. If an accident or event occurs, the insurance agency will call us to see if the volunteer involved is current on their monthly hours.
- **Minimal Mileage Reimbursement**—\$.14 per mile up to a capp of \$15 per month for those needing help with transportation expenses for volunteering. This reimbursement is payable every quarter. Your supervisor must sign your Timesheet and we must receive it by the 10th of each month.
