FREE VOLUNTEER BENEFITS

All enrolled RSVP 55+ & CCCV 50+senior volunteers are eligible to receive our **FREE \$1M Accident/Liability Supplemental Insurance** benefit as long as you have an Enrollment Form on file and turn in your volunteer hours each month. If an accident or event occurs, the insurance agency will call us to see if the volunteer involved is current on their monthly hours.

RSVP & CCCV enrolled volunteers are also eligible for a minimal mileage reimbursement if needed. To receive this benefit, **you MUST turn in our official Monthly Timesheet with your supervisors signature on it.** This benefit accumulates monthly and pays out quarterly, up to maximum of \$15 per month.
