- ◆ **Project LifeSaver Program**

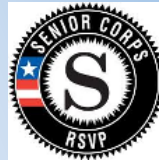

Benefits We Provide

Whether you volunteer with the RSVP or CCCV Senior Volunteer Program, we provide you with the following **FREE BENEFITS**:

- ◆ \$1M supplemental accident/liability policy when you regularly submit your monthly volunteer hours to our office.
- ◆ You are also eligible for a minimal transportation reimbursement capped at \$15 per month, paid out quarterly. This requires a supervisors signature on the SVS Timesheet.
- ◆ An **annual invitation to our May Volunteer Recognition Event** to celebrate the hours of service invested thru our nonprofit partners.
- ◆ Over **200 Volunteer Opportunities** available countywide.

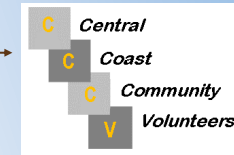


Retired & Senior Volunteer Program

RSVP receives major funding from the Corporation for National & Community Service and has been in operation in San Luis Obispo County for over 46 years.

RSVP connects **volunteers age 55 and over** with service opportunities in their communities that match their skills and availability. From serving Veterans to mentoring children, from enhancing the capacity of non-profit organizations to improving and protecting the environment, RSVP volunteers put their unique talents to work to make a difference.

RSVP offers maximum flexibility and choice to its volunteers as it matches the personal interests and skills of older Americans with opportunities to serve their communities. Our RSVP volunteers choose how and where they want to serve—whether on a one-time basis for special events, or a few hours scheduled weekly, our volunteers discuss their scheduling needs with the Volunteer Coordinator of the agency of their choice to determine what works best for them.



CCCV 50+

This new volunteer program enables us to continue serving ALL the nonprofits and government agencies within our geographical area.

"Our goal is to retain agencies and volunteers who no longer qualify under the revised Federal guidelines, to increase the total pool of senior volunteers in service to our communities and to attract younger seniors."
